Fun Facts about U.S. Currency:

- The largest bill ever printed was the \$100,000 bill in 1934. It was called the Gold Certificate.
- U.S. Money is actually printed on a cotton/linen material, not paper. This helps it last longer!
- Almost half of all bills printed by the U.S. are \$1 bills.
- Coins are printed by the U.S. Mint, while bills are printed by the Bureau of Engraving & printing.
